### Week 1 - Dedicate & Submit

### Week 2 - Provide & Guide

Pray that God would fill us with the Holy Spirit and guide us step by step. Thank God for his provision and daily guidance in our lives.

### Week 3 - Save & Protect

Pray for the people that don't know Christ and that are not connected to the church. Specifically list people you know by name and pray that they would take their next steps toward Christ. Pray that these initiatives will help their lives to be impacted, so that ultimately they will hear and respond to the Gospel. Pray for protection for you and your family, our teams, and people involved in these initiatives. Thank God for his protection, deliverance, and salvation.

### Week 4 - Students & Campus Connectors

Pray specifically for the students at our schools and for favor with the staff at these schools. Pray for student ministry staff - Brad Chandler, James Griffin, and Christie Smith. Ask God to send the right people to serve as campus connectors to help us reach students and families in our community.

### Week 5 - West Paulding Campus & The Launch Network

Pray specifically for the launch of our West Paulding Campus on September 12 at Poole elementary. Pray for Dave Cole, Steve Veale, Kay Locke, the launch team, and for the staff at Poole Elementary. Pray for our new church planting network - "The Launch Network" and Mac Lake as he provides leadership for this initiative.

### Week 6 - Serve & Give

Ask God to show you what role you can play in this next chapter of His story. Pray that God would open the hearts and minds of people so they can serve and give in these initiatives. Pray for our services on August 8 as people are challenged to give.
